From Hwy 26, Mt. Hood

- Heading West on Hwy 26 turn Left on Kelso Dr. (just past Sandy)
- Follow Kelso Dr. until it turns into Amisigger
- Follow Amisigger around to the left
- Turn Right onto Hwy 224
- Camp Kuratli entrance will be on your right, ½ mile
